NOTES:

1. This accounting of Available Programming Hours lost does not count the roughly 14 hours of yard time that A1/A unassigned prisoners have lost, and the roughly 10 hours of yard time that A2/B prisoners have lost due to the recent adoption of a tier-rotation program. (Prior to this, A1/A unassigned prisoners were allowed to access the yard for both periods, seven days a week; A2/B prisoners were allowed to access the yard for both periods, five days a week, but not on the weekends.)
2. In previous iterations of the Daily Activity Schedule, it was noted that training times were not to exceed 45 minutes.
3. This accounting also does not count the loss of religious programming on Tuesday and Thursday mornings, which will amount to another two hours.
4. This accounting does not count the loss of phone time to prisoners on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.
5. This accounting does not count the loss of access to packages and canteen on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.
6. This accounting does not count the loss of access to self-help and/or peer-to-peer rehabilitative programming on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.
